At the beginning of 2020, the spread of the novel coronavirus has so far caused 564 deaths with 28,138 confirmed cases in China. Hubei has been the worst-hit by this epidemic, with over 15 cities put on lockdown as the virus spread outwards from the provincial capital of Wuhan. Daily essentials and health supplies are out of stock. People and hospitals are suffering from this situation. WenLin Chinese School is stepping up to help the victims of the unprecedented coronavirus outbreak. We have donated £5,000 to Hubei branch of the Red Cross Society of China (RCSC) as an immediate contribution to assist. Our hearts go out to all impacted by this situation, particularly those in China which is the home country of our school's staff. We sincerely hope this donation will support the efforts to fight the virus.

In the education field, WenLin Chinese School pays close attention to children and young people's mental health. We have donated £2,400 in total to Place2Be to support their work in 2020. Place2Be is a children's mental health charity that provides counselling and mental health support and training in UK schools.
